If the maximum number of 12 can be made up of Wardens & Chief Wardens we can combine the 2 courses.

This theory based course is designed to impart the necessary knowledge required to implement the emergency response procedures specified in the Workplace Emergency Response Manual or specified by a person in a higher level of the Emergency Control Organisation (ECO).

It also covers decision making about people's safety during a workplace emergency and to give instructions on the priority order for responding to the emergency incident area.

Students will be set tasks involving workplace emergency scenarios, learn about the fire equipment and emergency equipment contained within their building and learn about search procedures.

(Written Assessment)

First 4 hr session is for all ECO members. Chief Warden, Deputy Chief Warden, Floor/Area Wardens & Wardens. At the conclusion of the first 4 hours the Floor/Area Wardens and Wardens will leave.	\$1200.00 for 4 hours.
